Priming is the result of a speaker encountering evidence and generalising from it [Primings come] from single focussed and generalising encounters Language teaching materials and language teachers can provide essential shortcuts to primings (Hoey 2005: 185f) Yet to accept the theory of Lexical Priming as valid and useful in second lan-
